Walla Walla Valley is experiencing a child care crisis!

To do this, we need to support providers in starting and expanding **flexible** services, increase the child care **workforce**, and decrease the **costs** for families and providers.

OUR MISSION:

There are few incentives to become a child care provider or early childhood educator. To increase the amount of child care in the Valley, we need to increase and support our child care workforce.

FLEXIBILITY

Parents need the flexibility of child care options that fit their work schedules, no matter what hours and days of the week. Providers need the flexibility to operate the facility that works best for them, be it in their home or in a child care center. We need to support providers in starting or expanding their businesses and offer incentives to provide care at non-standard hours.

COST

It's expensive to pay for child care and it's expensive to provide child care. To support families, we can offer child care tuition assistance, flexible spending accounts, and other benefits. To help providers, we can offer them space, free advertising and marketing services, and discounted products or services among other supports.
