In 2021, in partnership with Arrowleaf Consulting, the City of Walla Walla, and Columbia County Health System, the Walla Walla Valley Early Learning Coalition conducted a feasibility study titled *Creating an Accessible and Affordable Valley Wide Child Care System*. In this study, we learned that families and employers needed a single comprehensive resource to look for child care and understand the available options. This directory, along with its online companion at www.earlylearningwallawalla.org/wallawallachildcare, is our response to that need.

There are a variety of options in our area, including private licensed child care, public preschool programs offered by school districts, and unlicensed private partial day preschools. As with any kind of service, we encourage families to be informed consumers and research the best options for your children. 



SUBSIDIES ACCEPTED OR OFFERED

Washington State Working Connections Child Care (WCCC) is a state subsidy program that pays a portion of tuition costs for child care directly to the provider with program eligibility based on household income. Rates are based on type of care (family home versus center) and age of child (infant, toddler, etc.). Families making less than 65% of state median income are eligible for the subsidy with the portion of costs that parents pay capped at \$115 per month.


Washington State Seasonal Child Care program is a state subsidy program that pays a portion of tuition costs for children whose guardians are seasonally employed in agricultural work. Rates are based on type of care (family home versus center) and age of child (infant, toddler, etc.).



Military Child Care Fee Assistance pays up to \$1,500 per child per month to providers to support tuition costs for children of military members on active duty, in the guard or reserve, army civilians, and guard and reserve technicians.

Providers can offer specific subsidies or discounts not supported by state or federal funds. These are different depending on the provider, but can look like multiple child discounts, multiple year enrollment discounts, or scholarships.






Child Care Centers

Child Care Centers are programs that operate in a licensed facility that is not in a private home or school.

Centers have classrooms or well-defined spaces that serve specific age groups with age-dependent maximum capacities and staff to child ratios. Like licensed family child care homes, private center providers set their own monthly or daily rates. Many providers accept or offer tuition assistance in form of subsides, sibling discounts or scholarships. More information is available on pg. 6 of this guide.






Early Childhood Education Assistance Program (ECEAP), Head Start, and Early Head Start

ECEAP is an early learning program funded by Washington State for children ages 3 and 4. Program eligibility is based on family income in relation to the Washington State Median Income (SMI). In 2022, family income has to be at or below 36% of SMI for a child to qualify for the program. Children who have been identified by their school district for special education, children with an Individualized Education Plan (IEP), children experiencing homelessness, and tribal children at or below 100% SMI are also eligible for ECEAP. Final eligibility for all programs will be determined by program staff.

Head Start and Early Head Start are other early learning program funded by the federal government. Head Start programs are for children ages 3 and 4, while Early Head Start programs serve children birth to 3 years old and pregnant women. Program eligibility is based on family income in relation to the federal poverty level (FPL). In 2022, family income has to be at or below 130% FPL. Children experiencing homelessness, children in foster care, and children in families with Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) cash grants are also eligible for Head Start programs. Final eligibility for all programs will be determined by program staff.




Transitional Kindergarten

Transitional Kindergarten, also called TK, is a school-based program for children under five years old who did not have previous access to early learning and have been screened by the school district to need preparation before entering kindergarten. Oversight for TK is provided by the Washington Office of the Superintendent of Public Instruction and local school districts.

Partial Day Preschools

Partial day preschools operate privately on a half day or less schedule. Each partial day preschool has their own schedule offerings and can include morning classes, afternoon classes, and classes offered on specific days of the week. These preschools are not licensed through DCYF.


